## **WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR *EARLY ON*?**

Children from birth to 36 months who have a 20% developmental delay in any area including motor development, language, social-emotional, cognitive or self-help skills, vision or hearing difficulties are eligible for Early On. In addition, children who have a medical condition that most likely will impact their development are also eligible for Early On.

## **HOW WILL DEVELOPMENT CENTERS' *EARLY ON* PROGRAM HELP MY CHILD?**

If your child is eligible for Early On, we will support you to:

- Know your rights while participating in Early On
- Effectively communicate your child's needs
- Help your child learn and develop

A family service coordinator will meet with you in your home and provide the following:

- A developmental assessment and history of your child under three years old.
- A family interview where your concerns, needs and priorities for your child will be discussed.
- Determine Early On eligibility and coordinate an Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) based on what you want to happen for your child.
- Identifying and linking to community resources/services which address your child's needs and priorities.
- Provide monthly home visits, developmental activities, information, and service coordination.
